

Jørgen Blomqvist is Honorary Professor of international copyright. He teaches international intellectual property law and undertakes research in the interpretation of the core international conventions on copyright and related rights, the Berne Convention for the Protection of Literary and Artistic Works and the Rome Convention for the Protection of Performers, Producers of Phonograms and Broadcasting Organizations.

Formerly, Jørgen Blomqvist was Director, Copyright Law Division, at the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and he is continuously active in international development cooperation undertaking various ad-hoc assignments from WIPO. He is also a member of the panel of advisors of UBVA, the Committee for the Protection of Rights of Professional Workers.

In addition he is a member of the Board of the Danish Copyright Association and member of the Executive Committee of the International Literary and Artistic Association (ALAI).
